 - 3.1 Bref résumé de la problématique :

Alternative facts or falsehoods? Many people in the USA are drawn to conspiracy theories, perhaps more nowadays than in the recent past. How do researchers define the term Conspiracy Theory and explain its success in certain populations? Are people influenced by the language used to promote these theories? What is the impact and the consequence of such beliefs? The goal of this *Travail de Maturité* is to better understand the current conflict between those who believe in a particular conspiracy theory and those who do not.

You will focus on Conspiracy Theory from a scientific point of view, including research into the idea of belief, the use of specific language, and the American society. You will read specialist articles in books and academic journals to explain different theories which are presented, supply your own examples and finally discuss and draw your conclusions based on the gathered information. If you choose to do a survey, your data will be collected and discussed.
